WOSC Vaccination Policy - Staff, Team Officials and Match Officials

I. DEFINITIONS

The following terms have these meanings in this Policy:

“WOSC Staff” – All full-time or part-time Technical or Operational WOSC Staff.

“Team Official” – All paid and/or volunteer coaches in any program level at WOSC. In addition, this would include team managers or treasurers that would have direct physical access to any member of the team

“Match Official” – Any paid or volunteer person that referees any league, exhibition or scrimmage.

II. PURPOSE

WOSC will take its direction from Ontario Soccer (OS) and Ottawa Public Health (OPH). We continue to operate in a fluid environment. Government mandates, the recently announced provincial digital vaccination certificate, venue protocols and requirements continue to evolve and are subject to change. We will update any affected parties as required.

This Policy applies to all WOSC Staff, Team Officials and Match Officials.

Effective September 22, all WOSC Staff, Team Officials and Match Officials will be required to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days).

Exemptions will be allowed for verified medical and Ontario Human Rights Code reasons.

If proof of vaccination has not been provided;

- WOSC Staff will be placed on immediate unpaid leave.
- Team Officials will not be permitted to attend any game or training sessions.
- Match Officials will not be permitted to referee any games or training sessions.
